Kodai-ji Temple: one of the best places in Kyoto for viewing the autumn leaves and cherry blossoms, which was founded by Kita Masasho (Nene), the wife of Toyotomi Hideyoshi, to mourn her husband.

Kiyomizu-Dera Temple: one of the most famous temples in Japan and best known for its wooden stage that rises 13 meters from the hillside above the main hall.

Yasaka Koshin-do Temple: popular for being instagrammable.

Yasaka Pagoda: a landmark in Higashiyama.

It has been designated as a national historic site, with scenic beauties, such as Togetsukyo Bridge and Sagano Bamboo Forest. We will take you to Tenryu-ji Temple, a temple complex and garden with a beautiful view of Arashiyama, Nonomiya Shrine, one of the most famous power spots for matchmaking in Kyoto.

Okochi-Sanso Villa, a circuit style garden created by Denjiro Okochi, who was a period drama star in early Showa and who invested his own money in the garden.

The Kansai region is home to two famous sake breweries: Nada in Hyogo and Fushimi in Kyoto. Fushimi, where numerous legends of great natural springs remain, has long been the home of sake brewing. We will take you on a tour to learn about the brewing process of sake called Fushimi no Onna-zake (Fushimi's feminine sake), which is made from soft water to produce gentle, mellow, and sweet sake.

Let's stroll through the elegant town, where traditional sake breweries stand side by side.

Then we will take you to Ohara, a place full of mountain village atmosphere. The peaceful mountain village offers a soothing and relaxing experience with a view of Japanese original scenery. Let's feel the flow of time in a garden that changes its expression from season to season and in a temple that is quietly nestled in a mountain village.

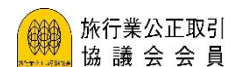
